Trolley a key museum draw

As a tourist attraction, the trolley car still has legs.

The **New York Museum of Transportation**, located on East River Road in the town of Rush, reported an 18.3 percent increase in attendance in 2009.

Museum officials attributed the improvement to the electric trolley rides offered during the summer and holidays. The museum uses the trolley to connect to a diesel-and-caboose train for runs to the neighboring Rochester & Genesee Valley Railroad Museum.

"We're the only electric trolley operation in New York state," museum president Ted Strang said. "We know of no other place in the United States that offers two rail museums with a ride between them."
