

# RBA seeks nominations for 2010 Top 100 companies ranking

The Rochester Business Alliance is seeking nominations for the 2010 Rochester Top 100, a program that determines and then honors the 100 fastest-growing private **companies** in the region.

Eligible companies must be independent, meaning they're headquartered here and not the Rochester branch of a parent **company** based elsewhere; be privately held; and have revenue of at least \$1 million in each of the three most recent fiscal years.

The region as defined by the RBA and its co-sponsor, KPMG, includes Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans, Seneca, Wayne, Wyoming and Yates counties.
