ROCHESTER, N.Y.--The State Labor Department reports that Rochester gained 1,500 private sector jobs between October 2009 and October 2010.

It's the highest year-over-year job gain in about two years

according to State Labor Analyst Kevin Jack. Industries seeing some of the greatest growth according to Jack are professional services such as law, architecture and accounting.

The Rochester Business Alliance said it had been seeing an up-tick in temporary hiring, but more firms are bringing workers aboard permanently. Such growth, said spokeswoman Ellen Rosen was expected, the question many had was when it would occur. Many of the jobs that have been added are in historically high-paying fields which Jack said bodes well for future financial quarters.
